Jacobson/Hydrowest Inc. and Chris Sinclair/Northbrook Energy LLC. hold a number of Federal licenses for hydroelectric plants under the Commissions jurisdiction; as such, they are actively engaged in purchasing distressed hydroelectric assets and returning them to service as compliant renewable power producers. The semi-annual FERC Regional Office "Inoperative Hydroelectric Plant Report" is a fundamentally useful tool in identifying inoperative (and thus possibly distressed) plants for acquisition. Our business plan serves the public interest by making non-functioning and non-compliant power plants operational and compliant. The San Francisco and New York Regional Engineer's have already posted, as publicly available information on the FERC E-Library, the Project Numbers of the plants on their region's Inoperative list (SEE: Issuance 20101101-0482 and Issuance 20091029-0087); for unknown reasons, the other FERC regional offices have not. Since much of the information requested is already public, we do not believe that the referenced Inoperative list has any sort of National Security or commercially protected status, that providing such Project numbers is already Commission policy, that our request simply extends what the FERC SFRO and NYRO are already doing and thus the complete report for all regions should be readily available as it would simply standardize policy among regional offices, and that the public and the environment would be beneficiaries of plant improvement efforts directly resulting from the disclosure of the requested reports. Therefore: Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. ss 552 ("FOIA") and the regulations promulgated thereunder by the Commission, 18 C.F.R. ss 388 (the FOIA Regulations), Jacobson/Hydrowest and Sinclair/Northbrook request the latest semi-annual Inoperative Hydroelectric Plant Report from each and every FERC Regional Office. The FDIC link you referenced doesn't store the actual contract, only government contract obligation data description fields, much like a cross between a private citizen's check stub and survey data pertinent to identifying what characteristics of goods and services the government purchases. I appreciate your efforts.

Was the last procurement that resulted in this requested contract handled through FedBIZOpps? If so, then FedBIZOpps would probably have a copy of the past RFP and all RFP modifications that I can access separately. But I would need the RFP # (usually listed in the initial pages of the contract, perhaps the signature page of the contract).

That could cut down the amount of paper copy. The contract will have a executed signature page, drop sections L & M, then add contract modifications, etc as the vehicle is exercised.

REQUEST: In a March 3, 2012 filing in the EL01-100, EL01-10-026 et al dockets, Idaho Power Company, IDACORP Energy L.P. and the City of Tacoma, Washington filed a Stipulation and Agreement (accession no. 20120302-5046) that redacted the settlement amount in item 4 on page 6. A "privileged" version of this document (accession no. 20120302-5047) was also filed that presumably did not redact the settlement figure. In filing a redacted version of the document for the public record, the parties cited Rule 388.112 of the Commission's Rules of Practices and Procedure and their desire to preserve the confidentiality of the deal while they negotiate with other parties in the Northwest Refund Proceeding. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), I hereby request a copy of the settlement without redaction of the settlement figure. Under 388.112(c)(i), the commission "retains the right to make determinations with regard to any claim of privilege or CEII status, and the discretion to release information as necessary to carry out its jurisdictional responsibilities." I submit to you that FERC must release the unredacted settlement in order to carry out its jurisdictional public interest responsibilities. Secrecy may well serve the needs of settlement negotiations, but in this case the need for secrecy is clearly far outweighed by the public interest. The Northwest Proceeding has been going on for over 10 years. It involves millions of unrecouped ratepayer dollars that have been in limbo for all that time. U.S. Citizens, as well as the customers of IDACORP, and especially those of Tacoma--which after all is a consumer-owned municipal utility that should have a strong bias toward public disclosure--all have a compelling interest in knowing the amount of the settlement: • Citizens deserve to know because the Western Power Crisis was enabled in part through the creation of public policy, in which FERC was complicit, and they have a right to learn the consequences of policies adopted and implemented in their name. • IDACORP customers deserve to know, because it is the cost they will pay in power rates for whatever errors IDACORP made as a FERC-certified marketer. • And Tacoma customers have a right to know because it represents the compensation they are at long last receiving for the real damage done to them in the form of rate increases and other serious economic consequences due to the enormous mess that FERC helped to create and exacerbate. FERC has already gone out of its way to protect the negotiations in the Northwest Proceeding by allowing the claimants to file details of their claims secretly with a small, select group of parties (see Chief ALJ Curtis Wagner Jr.'s Settlement Procedure Order, accession no. 20111123-3048). Therefore I request that any and all fees in connection with this request be waived. Request withdrawn via e-mail-3/16/12.
