Reference: Revisions to Rate Schedules and Service Agreements

Dear Mr. Grygar:

1. On March 26, 2004, Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company, LLC (Panhandle), filed revised tariff sheets¹ to modify the Applicability and Character of Service provisions of certain rate schedules. Specifically, Panhandle revises section 2 of Rate Schedules FT, EFT, SCT, IOS, WS, PS, FS, LFT, and HFT to provide that contract quantity is uniform throughout the contract term except when Panhandle and a shipper, on a not unduly discriminatory basis, agree to a different level of Maximum Daily Contract Quantity or Maximum Stored Quantity for specified periods within the contract term. Panhandle also makes attendant changes to the corresponding pro forma service agreements.

2. The Commission noticed Panhandle's filing on March 30, 2004, permitting comments, protests, or interventions as provided in Section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214) all timely filed motions to intervene and any motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the date this order issues are granted. No party protests or opposes Panhandle's filing.

3. Consistent with Commission action in Texas Eastern Transmission, L.P.,² we accept Panhandle's revised tariff sheets effective April 26, 2004, as proposed. This acceptance benefits the public by increasing shipper flexibility.
