ORDER ADDRESSING INCOMPLETE FILINGS
INVOLVING GRANDFATHERED AGREEMENTS

(Issued June 29, 2004)

1. On June 29, 2004, Presiding Administrative Law Judges Carmen A. Cintron and Karen V. Johnson issued an order¹ stating that, in accordance with the Commission's May 26, 2004 order,² those entities who submitted joint filings responding to the Commission's request for information on six categories of grandfathered agreement (GFA) information in this proceeding on or before June 25, 2004³ would not be included in the hearing described in Step 2 of the May 26, 2004 Order. The presiding judges also stated that "[t]hose parties whose joint filings contain incomplete GFA information shall contact the Secretary's Office to correct the deficiencies."⁴
