ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued July 29, 2005)

1. On May 26, 2005, Entergy Services, Inc. (Entergy Services) filed a Settlement Agreement among East Texas Electric Cooperative, Sam Rayburn G&T Electric Cooperative and Tex –La Electric Cooperative and Entergy Services, in the above captioned docket. Initial comments in support of the Settlement Agreement were filed by the Commission Trial Staff on June 13, 2005. No other comments were filed. The Presiding Administrative Law Judge certified the Settlement Agreement, as uncontested, to the Commission on July 7, 2005.
2. The Settlement resolves all contested issues in the above captioned docket including all issues regarding the Fifth Revised Network Integration Transmission Services Agreement. The Settlement states that the Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824c.
3. The designation on these tariff sheets is in compliance with Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets, Order No. 614, *FERC Statutes and Regulations, Regulations Preambles July 1996 – December 2000* ¶ 31,096 (2000), and therefore the tariff sheets are accepted for filing as designated, to be effective on the date specified in the Settlement.
4. The Settlement Agreement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

5. This order terminates Docket No. ER05-356-000.
