ORDER VACATING CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZATION

(Issued May 9, 2008)

1. On July 20, 2006, the Commission authorized Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (Tennessee) to construct and operate 7.8 miles of 24-inch diameter pipeline in Essex and Middlesex Counties, Massachusetts to connect Tennessee's Beverly-Salem Line 270C-100 to Distrigas of Massachusetts, L.L.C.'s (DOMAC) Line 270C-1100.¹ DOMAC was the sole customer for the project's proposed 82,300 Dth/d of capacity.
2. On April 17, 2008, Tennessee filed a letter informing the Commission that delays from a protracted permitting process have caused the project to become uneconomical and that, accordingly, Tennessee and DOMAC have agreed to discontinue the project. Because the two parties to this project have decided not to proceed, the Commission will vacate the certificate authorization granted in this proceeding.

The Commission orders:

The certificate authorization granted on July 20, 2006, in Docket No. CP06-18-000 is vacated.
