ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued March 25, 2005)

1. On January 11, 2005, Renaissance Power, L.L.C., (Renaissance) filed a settlement agreement between Renaissance, Consumers Energy Services (Consumers) and the Michigan Electric Transmission Company, L.L.C. (METC). On January 31, 2005, Trial Staff filed comments in support of the settlement. No other comments were filed. On February 28, 2005, the presiding settlement judge certified the uncontested settlement to the Commission.

2. The settlement resolves the issues set for hearing, including Renaissance's revenue requirement for the provision of Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation Sources Service. The subject settlement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The tariff sheets contained in the settlement in the referenced case are in compliance with Order No. 614 and are made effective as noted in the settlement *Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets*, Order No. 614, 65 Fed. Reg. 18,221, (FERC Statutes and Regulations, Regulations Preambles July 1996 – December 2000 ¶ 31,096 (2000)). The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of or precedent regarding any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act. 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000).

3. This order terminates Docket No. ER04-992-000.
