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ORDER ACCEPTING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

(Issued August 9, 2004)

1. On May 26, 2004, the applicants PJM Transmission Owners filed an uncontested settlement agreement. The agreement withdraws the filing that gave rise to this proceeding. The Commission Trial Staff and the Joint Consumer Advocates, consisting of the Pennsylvania Office of Consumer Advocate, the Maryland Office of People's Counsel, the Ohio Office of Consumers' Counsel, the Consumer Advocate Division of the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, the Office of People's Counsel for the

District of Columbia and the Delaware Public Advocate support the settlement agreement. No other comments were filed. On June 17, 2004, the Presiding Administrative Law Judge certified the settlement as uncontested.

2. As recommended by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge, the PJM TOs must submit a replacement sheet in their tariffs consistent with Order No. 614. The PJM TOs are directed to replace the existing tariff sheets in Schedule 12A with a blank sheet, containing a reservation, in anticipation of a January 2005 filing, within 15 days of the date of issuance of this order.

3. The subject settlement is in the public interest and is hereby accepted. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

4. Schedule 12A of the PJM OATT is deemed withdrawn, effective January 5, 2004. The PJM Transmission Owners' February 2, 2004 compliance filing currently pending in Docket No. ER04-156-003 is moot. No amounts have been collected under Schedule 12A. Accordingly, no refunds are required. Docket Nos. ER04-156-000, ER04-156-001, ER04-156-003 and EL04-41-000 are hereby terminated.

5. Requests for rehearing of the Commission's January 2, 2004 and January 16, 2004 Orders in the instant proceeding are currently pending in Docket Nos. ER04-156-002 and EL04-41-001, and in Docket Nos. ER04-156-004 and EL04-41-002, respectively. All such pending rehearing requests are deemed withdrawn and the associated dockets are terminated.
