ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR FILINGS

(Issued February 27, 2006)

1. On December 8, 2005, the Commission issued *Repeal of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 and Enactment of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 2005*, Order No. 667, FERC Stats. & Regs. ¶ 31,197 (2005), which, in newly-adopted 18 C.F.R. § 366.4, provided for holding companies to notify the Commission no later than March 10, 2006 of their status as a holding company, and for holding companies that sought exemption from or waiver of the Commission's regulations to file for such exemption or waiver.

2. The Commission finds that it is appropriate to extend the date for filing specified in newly-adopted 18 C.F.R. § 366.4 to no later than 14 days after the Commission issues an order on rehearing in the above-captioned docket. However, entities may choose to file prior to that date.
