Senate Votes to Confirm Danly as FERC Commissioner

The U.S. Senate today confirmed James Danly to join the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Danly, who currently serves as the Commission's General Counsel, will serve the remainder of a term that expires June 30, 2023.
