




U.S. NG Supply and Demand June 2013 vs. June 2014




Regional Canadian Imports



Total U.S. Natural Gas Demand All Sectors




U.S. Natural Gas Consumption for Power Generation







Monthly U.S. Dry Gas Production – Lower 48 States



NG Rig by Direction




