Dear Mr. Grabow:

1. On October 21, 2019, Wind Park Bear Creek, L.L.C. (Bear Creek) filed an Offer of Settlement and Settlement Agreement (Settlement) addressing the revenue requirement for the provision of Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service (Reactive Service) from Bear Creek's 24 MW wind turbine generating facility in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. On November 12, 2019, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. On November 22, 2019, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.

2. Article 4.1 of the Settlement states:

The standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under section 205 or section 206 of the Federal Power Act, including by the Commission acting *sua sponte*, shall be the ordinary "just and reasonable" standard of review.

- 3. The Settlement resolves all issues that were set for hearing and settlement judge procedures in Docket No. ER19-1730.² The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. Commission approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.
- 4. Bear Creek is directed to make a compliance filing with revised tariff records in eTariff format,³ within thirty (30) days of this order, to reflect the Commission's action in this order.
