ORDER EXTENDING COMPLIANCE EFFECTIVE DATE

(Issued November 7, 2016)

1. On June 16, 2016, the Commission issued an order¹ implementing certain clarifications to the existing Electric Quarterly Report (EQR) reporting requirements and the EQR Data Dictionary, pursuant to sections 205 and 220 of the Federal Power Act.² In particular, the June Order clarified existing EQR reporting requirements and associated fields in the EQR Data Dictionary related to "Increment Name" and "Commencement Date of Contract Terms." The June Order also affirmed the requirement that transmission providers must report transmission-related data in their EQRs; made certain updates to the EQR Data Dictionary with respect to the "Time Zone" field options; and deleted fields associated with reporting e-Tag ID data. In addition, the June Order clarified that future minor or non-material changes to EQR reporting requirements and the EQR Data Dictionary will be posted directly to the Commission's website and EQR

users will be alerted via email of these changes. The June Order stated that the updated EQR Data Dictionary adopted in the order would be applied to EQR filings beginning with the Q4 2016 EQR.³

- 2. Edison Electric Institute (EEI), Energy Compliance Consulting, LLC, and Wisconsin Electric Power Company and Wisconsin Public Service Corporation filed requests for rehearing and/or clarification of the June Order, which are currently pending.
- 3. Upon consideration, to provide additional time for public and non-public utilities to comply with the updated EQR Data Dictionary and given that requests for rehearing and/or clarification of the June Order are pending, the Commission will extend the deadline to comply with the updated EQR Data Dictionary adopted in the June Order from the O4 2016 EQR filing to the O1 2017 EQR filing.

The Commission orders:

The deadline for complying with the updated EQR Data Dictionary adopted in the June Order is hereby extended from the Q4 2016 EQR filing to the Q1 2017 EQR filing, as discussed in the body of this order.
