## ORDER TOLLING THE TIME FOR ISSUANCE OF AN ORDER

(Issued December 6, 2019)

- 1. On September 11, 2019, pursuant to section 292.207(b) of the Commission's regulations, <sup>1</sup> Broadview Solar, LLC (Broadview) filed an application for Commission certification of qualifying facility (QF) status (Application).
- 2. Notice of the Application was published in the *Federal Register*, 84 Fed. Reg. 49,291 (2019), with interventions and protests due on or before October 2, 2019. Edison Electric Institute and NorthWestern Corporation (NorthWestern) filed timely motions to intervene and protests. Broadview and NorthWestern filed answers.
- 3. Section 292.207(b)(3) of the Commission regulations requires the Commission to act within 90 days of the filing of an application for Commission certification of QF status.<sup>2</sup> Within 90 days, the Commission must inform the applicant that the application is deficient, issue an order granting or denying the application for qualifying status, or toll the time for issuance of such an order. In order to allow sufficient time for due consideration of the matters raised, we hereby toll the time for issuance of an order in this proceeding.
