Dear Mr. Mitchell:

1. On December 9, 2019, in the above-referenced proceeding, you filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) on behalf of Alliant Energy Corporate Services, Inc. (Alliant) addressing the annual revenue requirement for providing Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service from the Marshalltown Generating Station, under Schedule 2 of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff. On December 30, 2019, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On January 13, 2020, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.¹

2. Paragraph 9 of the Settlement states that

the standard of review applicable to the Commission's review and approval of the [Settlement] shall be the just and reasonable standard. The standard of review for any modifications to the [Settlement] proposed by a non-Party or by the Commission acting *sua sponte*, shall be the ordinary 'just and reasonable' standard.

3. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in Docket Nos. ER18-2280-002, ER18-2280-003, and ER18-2280-004. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

4. Alliant is directed to make a compliance filing with revised tariff records in eTariff format,² within 30 days of this order, to reflect the Commission's action in this order.
