Dear Ms. Dornan:

1. On March 2, 2020, Black Hills Shoshone Pipeline, LLC (Shoshone Pipeline) filed its annual filing related to the Lost and Unaccounted For (LAUF) percentage to be used for the period beginning April 1, 2020, pursuant to section 7.2.25 of the General Terms and Conditions (GT&C) of Shoshone Pipeline's FERC Gas Tariff, Volume No. 1. Shoshone Pipeline requests a temporary and limited waiver of GT&C section 7.2.25 in order to retain its currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent. For good cause shown, we grant the requested waiver and accept Shoshone Pipeline's currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent to be effective April 1, 2020.
2. Shoshone Pipeline's Attachment A shows its actual annual LAUF for 2019 was negative. Shoshone Pipeline states that, while throughput in 2019 was sporadic, should service be provided on the pipeline in the future, it would be expected to result in lost and unaccounted for volumes, and shippers receiving service at that time should be required to cover the LAUF. Therefore, Shoshone Pipeline requests that the Commission allow it to retain its currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent. Shoshone Pipeline states the LAUF would be recalculated in 2020.
3. Public notice of the filing was issued on March 3, 2020. Interventions and protests were due as provided in section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 154.210 (2019)). Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2019)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any unopposed motions to intervene filed out-of-time before the

issuance date of this order are granted. Granting late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No adverse comments or protests were submitted.

4. We accept Shoshone Pipeline's proposal to retain its currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent. We find that Shoshone Pipeline has shown good cause to grant the temporary and limited waiver of section 7.2.25 of its tariff to maintain a currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent. Accordingly, we grant Shoshone Pipeline's unopposed request for waiver and accept its currently effective LAUF percentage of 0.12 percent to be effective April 1, 2020.
