Dear Messrs. Bixby and Small:

1. On February 19, 2020, in the above-referenced proceeding, you filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) on behalf of the International Transmission Company, Michigan Electric Transmission Company, DTE Electric Company, and Consumers Energy Company addressing two *pro forma* Blackstart Resource Service Agreements and two associated rate formula templates. On March 10, 2020, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. On April 2, 2020, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.

- 3. The Settlement addresses all issues in dispute in Docket No. ER19-2241. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. Commission approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.
- 4. The tariff records filed with the Settlement are hereby accepted, effective August 24, 2019, as proposed.
