Dear Mr. Grabow:

1. On December 13, 2018, in Docket No. ER18-1704-001, you filed, on behalf of Stuttgart Solar, LLC (Stuttgart Solar), an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) between Stuttgart Solar; Entergy Services, LLC; Ameren Services Company; and Commission Trial Staff.¹ On January 2, 2019, Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On January 17, 2019, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.²

2. The Settlement concerns a rate schedule that specifies Stuttgart Solar's revenue requirement for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation Sources Service from the Stuttgart Solar Facility.

3. Section 4.1 of the Settlement states that:

[t]he standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under section 205 or section 206 of the Federal Power Act, including by the Commission acting *sua sponte*, shall be the ordinary “just and reasonable” standard of review.

4. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in Docket Nos. ER18-1704-000 and ER18-1704-001. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission’s approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings.

5. This letter order terminates Docket Nos. ER18-1704-000 and ER18-1704-001.
