Dear Mr. Levy:

1. On April 22, 2019, Constellation Power Source Generation, LLC (CPSG), Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon Generation), and Handsome Lake Energy, LLC (Handsome Lake and, together with CPSG and Exelon Generation, the Exelon Parties) filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) addressing the revenue requirements for the provision of reactive supply and voltage control service from CPSG's fossil-fueled generation facilities, Exelon Generation's various generation facilities, and Handsome Lake's natural gas-fired generation facility, which are all located in PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. The Settlement addresses all issues in dispute in Docket Nos. ER17-801, EL19-54, EL19-57, ER17-802, EL19-24, ER17-803, and EL17-50.¹ On May 13, 2019,

Commission Trial Staff filed comments supporting the Settlement. On June 12, 2019, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.²

2. Paragraph 41 of the Settlement states that “[t]he standard of review the Commission shall apply when acting on proposed modifications to this Settlement under Section 205 or Section 206 of the FPA, including by the Commission acting *sua sponte*, shall be the ordinary ‘just and reasonable’ standard of review.”

3. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. Commission approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.

4. The Exelon Parties are directed to make a compliance filing with revised tariff records in eTariff format,³ within 30 days of this order, to reflect the Commission’s action in this order.⁴
