On July 2, 2018, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) directed ISO New England Inc. (ISO-NE) to submit permanent revisions to the ISO-NE Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff (Tariff) reflecting improvements to its market design to better address regional fuel security concerns.¹ The revisions are due on October 15, 2019.² On April 22, 2019, ISO-NE, New England States Committee on Electricity (NESCOE), and New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Participants Committee jointly requested a public meeting to share with Commission staff, without violating the Commission's regulations prohibiting *ex parte* communications,³ information about efforts to develop these proposed Tariff revisions. In response to that request, Commission staff is convening this public meeting.
