1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 MR. CAVNER: My name is Dion Cavner; this is my
3 wife, Nancy Cavner. (spelling) We live -- oh, our land
4 goes within a half mile of this new --

5 MRS. CAVNER: Compression station.

6 MR. CAVNER: Compression station, compressor
7 station. And our main concern is the noise from this thing,
8 because it's south of our house. The engineer at the last
9 meeting told us that definitely we would not hear this at
10 all.

11 So if that happens, we have no problem. But as
12 big as these compressors are, I'm concerned about that.
13 Because I know, I read notes that they gave us, and the size
14 of these compressors -- I don't know how they're going to
15 quiet it. 124,710 horse? That's some big compressors.

16 So we moved to the country 20 years ago -- took
17 us 20 years to buy our land, so we've got 40 years invested
18 in this, and we moved for the quiet. We don't want the
19 quiet disturbed at all. It's not going to be an option for
20 us to have that interrupted at all.--

21 MRS. CAVNER: Then I did notice, after we talked
22 about that in Lindsay, it wasn't even listed as one of their
23 concerns, noise wasn't listed as one of their concerns. But
24 it was our concern, and we made that very clear. So I just
25 wanted to make sure that we have that listed.

1 MR. CAVNER: We're also concerned about the
2 fumes, if there's any compressor fumes, I don't know how
3 they'd do that. Because we're going to be north of this
4 station, and we don't want to have a bunch of exhaust fumes.
5 I'm not sure that that's a big deal, but it's a concer--

6 MRS. CAVNER: And how will they deal with leaks.
7 You know, we have cattle and cattle is our livelihood, so we
8 need to make sure they stay healthy and safe.

9 MR. CAVNER: What els--

10 MRS. CAVNER: And will there be any effect in the
11 water table? Ponds, we have some spring-fed ponds.

12 MR. CAVNER: Like I said, our main concern is the
13 noise. I'm not against the plant; I'm just against the
14 noise--

15 MRS. CAVNER: Right. And we just want everything
16 to be maintained safely.

17 MR. CAVNER: I mowed some of the compressor
18 stations south of Ratliff and all that, and I know how
19 noisy they are. And this one's going to be a lot bigger.
20 So that's my main concern.

21 We talked to the engineer --you his car--

22 MRS. CAVNER: It's still at the house. We talked
23 to everybody when we were at the Lindsay meeting.

24 MR. CAVNER: Yes. He's here tonight; I don't
25 remember his name. He's the one in the beard in the back.

1 I don't remember his name. I did tell him I was going to
2 move in with him if I can hear it. (Chuckle)

3 I think that's all.

4 (Pause)

5 (Additional:)

6 MRS. CAVNER: This is Nancy Cavner, and just one
7 additional comment is, I want to make sure that we don't see
8 this big plant south of our house.

9 MR. CAVNER: We told the engineer that if we
10 wanted to listen to noise, we'd move back to tow--

11 MRS. CAVNER: Thank you.

12 (No further comments.)

13 (Thereupon, at 7 p.m., the meeting closed.)
