FERC approved two new extreme cold weather reliability standards aimed at implementing key recommendations from the joint inquiry into 2021's Winter Storm Uri, and directed the North American Electric Reliability Corporation to modify them to address concerns related to applicability, ambiguity, a lack of objective measures and deadlines and prolonged, indefinite compliance periods. <u>Chairman Phillips Announces June 2023 New England Winter Gas-Electric Forum</u>

The Commission will <u>convene</u> a second New England Winter Gas-Electric Forum June 20, 2023, in Portland, Maine. This meeting is a follow-up on last September's New England Winter Gas-Electric Forum. It will focus on addressing reliability risks and having stakeholders propose potential solutions to address the winter reliability challenges in New England, Chairman Willie Phillips said.

Chairman Phillips <u>announced</u> the Commission will convene a forum to examine the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. capacity market and how best to guarantee it achieves the objective of ensuring resource adequacy at just and reasonable rates.
