



Chairman Willie Phillips: Market Monitors Support NAESB Report Recommendations

FERC Chairman Willie Phillips at the October Commission meeting called attention to <u>a letter</u> <u>from the Market Monitors</u> of all six RTOs and ISOs expressing support for the recommendations in NAESB's gas/electric harmonization reform report, the major feature of which was endorsement of a NERC-like reliability organization for the natural gas industry.

"I welcome the support of all six independent market monitors, not only for NAESB's recommendations but for their encouragement for FERC to, quote, take actions to use the recommendations in the report," Chairman Phillips said at the meeting. "I could not agree more."

FERC Moves to Protect Grid for Transition to Clean Energy Resources



FERC directed new reliability standards to protect the grid as the nation makes the transition to expanded use of clean energy technologies.

"These standards will help us solve one the biggest problems we're facing, as we make the transition to clean energy resources," Chairman Phillips said. "We need to make sure that these promising new technologies can enhance, not weaken, reliability of the grid. We mean it when we say that at FERC, reliability is, and remains, Job No. 1."

These technologies, known as inverter-based resources (IBRs), include solar photovoltaic, wind, fuel cell and battery storage resources and comprise a significant portion of new capacity projected to come online over the next decade.
