FERC, NERC Present Review of System Performance During January 2024 Arctic Storms

The <u>review</u> found that system operators did not need to cut power to any customers during the storms and that the electric grid and natural gas system largely operated without any major incidents. However, work remains on identifying critical natural gas infrastructure, timely communication of operational issues and enhanced gas-electric situational awareness to support electric reliability. The review looked at weather conditions, natural gas performance, planning and operations practices, and generator performance, focusing on progress since completion of the joint inquiries into Winter Storms Uri and Elliott and the December 2023 Blackstart Availability Study.
