FERC's authority to regulate regional transmission planning and cost allocation has long been recognized by the Commission and the courts, and nothing in the Supreme Court's decision overturning *Chevron* calls that into question, <u>Chairman Willie Phillips said July 1</u>.

FERC Seeks Comment on Dynamic Line Ratings Framework

FERC is seeking comment on a potential framework that would help wring efficiencies out of the existing transmission grid by requiring the use of dynamic line ratings (DLR), which utilize up-to-date forecasts of weather conditions to improve the accuracy and transparency of transmission line ratings.
