Chairman Rosner, at his first Commission Meeting since being [appointed](#) Chairman by President Trump, focused on the importance of building all kinds of energy infrastructure so all Americans can enjoy reliable, abundant, and affordable power.

The Chairman also announced efforts to open an important dialogue with the Regional Transmission Organizations and Independent System Operators (RTOs and ISOs) across the country on their perspectives on large load forecasting tools to support and accelerate the efficient interconnection of new large loads.

Wildfires and the Grid

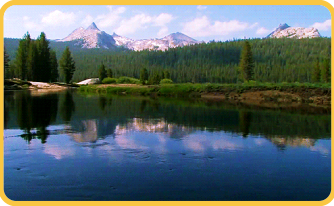

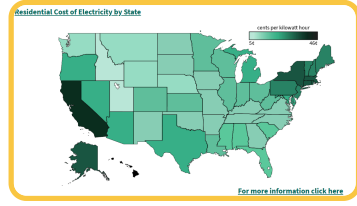
