NOTICE OF FILING TAKING EFFECT BY OPERATION OF LAW

(October 2, 2019)

On August 2, 2019, pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act (FPA),¹ Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (SPP) filed revisions to its Membership Agreement² to add definitions for the terms Load Serving Entity and Non-Load Serving Entity, with a requested effective date of October 1, 2019.

Pursuant to section 205 of the FPA, in the absence of Commission action on or before October 1, 2019, SPP's proposed revisions became effective by operation of law. Accordingly, the effective date of the proposed revisions is October 1, 2019.

The Commission did not act on SPP's filing because of a lack of quorum in this proceeding at this time. Consistent with section 205(g)(1)(B) of the FPA, any written statement explaining the views of a Commissioner with respect to SPP's filing will be added to the record of the Commission in the captioned proceeding.
